This audit evaluates the adherence level of **tech.argzero.org** as of June 11, 2020, to the "Web Content Accessibility Guidelines" (WCAG) 2.1 level AA success criteria.

Below you'll find the results for dozens of tests that focus mainly on 3 categories: **screen-reader** adjustments (for blind users), **keyboard navigation** adjustments (for the motor impaired) and **UI, design, and readability** adjustments (for the visually impaired).
